



Q. Who is the course designed for?

A. Predominantly site crew of temporary structure hire companies, including new starters. It's also useful for local authorities, event organisers, charities and businesses where their employees or volunteers are erecting a frame marquee for the first time.

Q. What will my crew members learn?

A. The fundamentals of how to erect a frame marquee, safely and effectively.

Q. How long does the course take to complete?

A. Around one hour.

Q. Is there a time limit?

A. No.

Q. How do I access the course?

A. Visit muta.learningnexus.co.uk

Q. How much does the course cost?

A. £29.99 for MUTA members and £39.99 for non-members.

Q. Are there any discounts for bulk purchases

A. No.

Q. Some of my crew members have been erecting frame marquees for years – should they take the course?

A. If you require evidence that your crew members have received formal training for their role then yes.

However, please note that the course is designed for crew members and new starters that need to understand the fundamentals of how to erect a frame marquee.

Q. Are there assessment questions?

A. Yes. There are a series of assessment questions after each module which candidates must answer correctly before progressing.

Q. Do candidates receive a certificate?

A. Yes. Candidates that successfully pass the course receive a certificate.

Q. How long is the certificate valid for?

A. There is no expiry date. Business owners and managers should decide when refresher training is required.

Q. How many modules are there?

A. Four.

Q. What are the four modules?

A. Frame connection and erection, PVC installation, finishing and checks, and dismantle.

Q. What format does the course take?

A. At the beginning of each module, candidates will watch a video. Once the video has been viewed, the candidate will be asked a series of questions based on what they watched.

Q. Does the course have to be taken on a laptop or PC?

A. No. It can also be taken on a mobile or tablet device.

Q. Do you need an internet connection to take the course?

A. Yes.

Q. What happens if crew members are interrupted part way through the course?

A. They can save their progress and return to the course at a later stage.

Q. Does the course cover health and safety principles?

A. Not in great detail. We recommend MUTA's StructureSafe online course if you're interested in a health and safety course.

Q. Can I promote that my crew members have completed the course?

A. Absolutely. Please promote the course in your marketing material and on social media.
